Virtual Annual Meeting

OBYC will hold its annual meeting of members on Saturday Aug. 20 at 4 pm. The meeting will be held virtually via Zoom. All members should have received invitations with the Zoom link.

The meeting will be led by Commodore, Kym Cournoyer, as a result of the resignation of the former Commodore. Under the club bylaws, the newly elected board of directors will meet to elect officers after the annual meeting.

All voting for directors was done by U.S. mail ballots sent to the membership. No nominations will be accepted during the Zoom meeting, although the ballots provided space for write-in candidates.

The candidates for three-year terms on the board of directors include two members who would be new to the board: Andy Rusczek and Philip Sumner Jr.
