Sailing School Kicks off with Pancakes!

The Abbot Fletcher Sailing School will kick off its summer season with the traditional Pancake Breakfast on Saturday, June 29. One and two-week classes start Monday July 1.

Erin Deschesne is returning as head instructor, joined by returning instructors Chloe Filipowicz and Karl Kreuze. Several volunteer instructors will join them.

There are still openings in all AFSS classes, except the beginner class starting July 8. About 30% of the enrolled students are children or grandchildren of OBYC members.

AFSS offers one and two-week classes for beginners and intermediate sailors finishing its season Aug. 9. There will be one racing program for advanced sailors.

AFSS operates separately from OBYC, while using club facilities and operational support. The club board has long supported AFSS as part of its mission to promote sailing and provide a high-quality sailing instruction program for the community.

The school relies on support from two fundraising events: the traditional Pancake breakfast welcomes all diners for plain and blueberry pancakes, sausage, real maple syrup and orange juice and coffee. Price is \$10 for adults and \$8 for children under 10.

The breakfast also features a raffle for a gift basket featuring items donated by club members. Barbara Messamore coordinates donations which include things needed for summer cottage vacations like playing cards, board games and bottles of wine.

The school also has a silent online auction at https://givebutter.com/c/afss2024 starting June 22 and extending to midnight July 11. The auction features gift certificates from numerous Bath, Brunswick and Harpswell merchants and restaurants as well as member donations.

Proceeds of the fundraisers are used by the school for operating expenses and replacement of boats, motors and other equipment as needed.

Lew Incze, one of the co-chairs of the sailing committee, reports that during the spring, committee members repainted the bottoms and touched up lettering of the three Boston Whalers used as coaching and safety boats by the program. The year before they sanded and sealed the woodwork.
